Although water covers approximately 67% of the Earth's surface, less than 3% is fresh water. Accounting for fresh water locked in glaciers, icecaps, or otherwise inaccessible, less than a tenth of a percent of the Earth's water is available for human consumption. Pollution, population growth, and wasteful irrigation practices are contributing to a worldwide water shortage. When the clear precious liquid becomes scarce, countries will begin to assert claims on fresh water supplies. As a result, drinkable water will become a cause of conflict and will eventually lead to greater hostilities among nations.

Some countries such as the United States have ample sources of water. For others such as China, water is less plentiful. As water resources dwindle, competition for available sources will rise. Nations may claim rights to a particular body of fresh water or they may plan to build dams and other projects. If two or more nations disagree on water rights or building projects, conflicts can emerge. In order to combat this issue many countries are adopting water conservation and security solutions. The United Nations has implemented programs to deal with potential issues of violence.

#### 四、翻譯(10%)

請翻譯以下幾個段落,取自 Noam Chomsky, "Humanity Imperiled: The Path to Disaster," TomDispatch.com (June 4, 2013):

What is the future likely to bring? A reasonable stance might be to try to look at the human species from the outside. So imagine that you're an extraterrestrial observer who is trying to figure out what's happening here or, for that matter, imagine you're an historian 100 years from now -- assuming there are any historians 100 years from now, which is not obvious -- and you're looking back at what's happening today. You'd see something quite remarkable.

For the first time in the history of the human species, we have clearly developed the capacity to destroy ourselves. That's been true since 1945. It's now being finally recognized that there are more long-term processes like environmental destruction leading in the same direction, maybe not to total destruction, but at least to the destruction of the capacity for a decent existence.
