 - 3. The poet's eye, in a fine frenzy rolling, doth glance from heaven to earth, from earth to heaven; and, as imagination bodies forth the forms of things unknown, the poet's pen turns them to shapes, and gives to airy nothing a local habitation and a name.
 - 4. True ease in writing comes from art, not chance, as those move easiest who have learned to dance. 'Tis not enough no harshness gives offense, the sound must seem an echo to the sense.
