"The accusation that Confucianism was used to stunt the development of pluralistic institutions may very well be true. Rulers in China as elsewhere around the world have frequently manipulated doctrine to suit their own purposes. Nevertheless, Confucianism was a house of many mansions and also served to limit the central power whose expansion it is accused of fostering. In rejecting Confucianism, modern detractors may well be turning their backs on a lifeboat that could offer them at least

temporary refuge, if not transportation to some more sheltered harbor in the future. The danger is that, by dwelling on the authoritarian uses to which Confucianism has been put by centralizing governments in the past, some contemporary scholars may have come greatly to underestimate the beneficial role that Confucian ideas have played through the long course of Chinese history. Confucianism may have been used to expand the power of the state, but it also provided moral limits to that power (limits, it is worth noting, that its totalitarian successors have ruthlessly ignored)."
